Every weekend of the year, as the tranquility of Shabbat enters us, our homes, our synagogues, and our community, the presence of an Eruv enhances our Shabbat. Whether it is pushing a stroller to shul or to a friend's home, carrying a Talit bag or house key or sefer, the Eruv significantly impacts every one of us each week.

A functioning Eruv requires an exacting, detailed, weekly inspection followed by timely repairs. Our employees spend 4-6 hours/week analyzing every attachment, fence, and twine that comprises the 25+ mile boundary of this Eruv. Over 1,000 details are reviewed each week, all while navigating traffic along with the weather that day, sometimes hot and humid, sometimes cold and wet, and sometimes windy and freezing.
